Order Management:

Logistics:

Ensure all internal and external SLAs are met. Responsible for managing the supply chain for the product range and additional product ranges as these arise. This includes the planning, stock control, purchasing and logistics requirements to ensure 100% continuity of supply of all products in all countries. Deal with daily inquiries from the business and vendors. Provide accurate detailed reporting on KPIs.

Major Tasks:

- Handle daily workflow cases from the business and email inquiries from internal and external partners.
- Control inventory levels of goods and telephone numbers at all facilities and vendors to ensure adequate supply is held at all times.
- Evaluate and handle issues related to different type of orders.
